<p>The City Council of the City of Olney, Texas, met Wednesday, September 22, 2021 at 3:00 P.M. Those present were: Mayor Rue Roger, Mayor Pro-Tem Parker, Councilmembers Harrison Wellman, Brad Simmons, and Chuck Stennett. Councilmember Terri Wipperman was absent. Staff Present: Interim City Administrator Arpegea Pagsuberon, City Secretary Tammy Hourigan and Public Works Director K.C. Blassingame. All agenda items were subject to action. <p>Councilmember Wellman stated that the Capital Outlay remaining in the Public Works Department needed some clarification. Public Works Director K.C. Blassingame was not present, so Ms. Pagsuberon stated that she would visit with him. It had been mentioned at the previous meeting that a mower and welder was needed since the Capital Outlay was not used to purchase another dump truck. Mr. Blassingame had checked and the mower that was wanted was not available. Councilmember Wellman asked what the level of need was for the requested items? It was also mentioned by Mayor Pro-Tem Parker that there are a Ford and a Dodge pickup that need to possibly taken in for service to be usable. Neither are currently running. The line items were reviewed but there was nothing that stood out as a problem as the items were reviewed. It was mentioned by Mayor Pro-Tem Parker that all departments most likely needed to have a Capital Outlay line item and then as money was spent it would have a line item.</p> <p>After review it was decided that there did not have to be an amendment. The Departments were not over Budget. There were line items over Budget, but the Departments as a whole were all within Budget. A discussion resulted in agreement that the funds budgeted could be spent and no amendment was needed. No action was taken at this time.</p>	2020-2021 AMENDED BUDGET WORKSHOP	
<p>Ms. Pagsuberon had made the Proposed Budget available to Councilmembers prior to the meeting. The numbers had been reviewed and were discussed. There were no major areas of concern. The Hotel/Motel Tax deficiency was questioned and Ms. Pagsuberon and Ms. Hourigan stated that they would research what was needed to collect those funds. Ms. Hourigan stated that the Revenue numbers had been entered and everything that was lacking at the previous meeting should be posted.
